

Invisible Ball

Description/Instructions:

This game is essentially playing catch with one or several invisible balls.

- The children all stand in a circle.
- Explain that you are holding an invisible ball.
- Call a child's name and throw them the ball.
- They have to mime catching the ball. They then call someone else's name and throw the ball to them.
- Once everyone knows each other's names you can introduce a second and possibly third ball.

How could this activity be adapted for different learners?

- Vary the number of balls being thrown around the circle.

What tools or equipment are needed?

An invisible ball.

What themes or topics could this activity support?

Senses – hearing. Communication skills. Non-verbal communication. Icebreaker.
