

## Name Discs

### Description/Instructions:

- Cut a branch, around 2" in diameter, into thin slices.
- Drill a small hole towards the edge of each piece to thread a piece of twine/cord through.
- Children then each write their name on a disc and decorate to use as a name tag.

### How could this activity be adapted for different learners?

- Name discs can be pre cut and drilled for younger children. Discs could be cut and/or drilled on site with older children.

### What tools or equipment are needed?

Bow saw and/or crosscut saw/back saw if cutting discs on site.  
Hand drill / auger / gimlet if drilling holes in discs on site.  
Twine/cord.  
Marker pens or chalk pens to write and draw on the discs.

### What themes or topics could this activity support?

Icebreaker.  
Development of tool use / motor skills if tools used.
