

Outdoor Art – Traced Bodies

Description/Instructions:

- One child lies down on the ground.
- Other children use twigs to create an outline of their body.
- They then collect natural materials to 'dress' the body and to add features.

How could this activity be adapted for different learners?

- Children could use several outlines to create scenes of people interacting with each other.
- Ask children to 'colour' their body so it is camouflaged as much as possible.
- Ask children to 'colour' their body so it stands out as much as possible.

What tools or equipment are needed?

Wheelbarrows, bags or baskets for moving leaves or materials around.
