

## Knife



<b>Use</b>	Whittling.
<b>How</b>	Blade facing away from you on the outside of your body. Keeping wood between you and the knife.
<b>Stand</b>	Sheath until hearing a click. Stand holding the handle with the blade facing down.
<b>Walk</b>	Sheath until hearing a click. Stand holding the handle with the blade facing down.
<b>Pass</b>	Holding sheathed part, offer handle to other person.
<b>Placed</b>	Sheath until hearing a click and place next to you with the handle facing forwards and the blade inwards.
<b>Gloves</b>	No glove on tool hand. A glove can be worn on the helper hand.
<b>Maintenance</b>	Sharpen using a sharpening stone.
<b>Cleaning</b>	Use a cloth and oil to remove dirt and moisture from the blade.
<b>Storage</b>	Store it a waterproof toolbox or container. Check the tool is clean and dry before storing and ensure the sheath is covering the blade.

## Tool Talk

- This is a fixed blade knife.
- This is the handle.
- This is the cover.
- I take the cover off like this.
- This is the blade.
- This is the cutting edge.
- When I have finished with the knife I put the cover back on like this.
- I stand with the knife like this.
- I walk with the knife like this.
- I pass the knife like this.
- When I use the knife I use it two arms and a tools length away from anyone except my partner like this.
- I use the knife to cut cord and to whittle.
- I have bare hands on the tool.
- I have a glove on my helper hand.
- When I am not using the knife I put it down with the handle facing forwards and the blade facing inwards.
- When I have finished with the knife I put it in the designated place or in the toolbox provided.
